• The incorporation of sustainable practices as a point of difference in wine tourism has gained traction in recent years (Alonso et al., 2020)



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WILDFLOWERS IN THE VINEYARD


• Wildflower planting in vineyards enhances biodiversity, attracts beneficial insects, and adds to the beauty of the landscape

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- The Karearea is a native NZ falcon and is our most threatened bird of prey.
- The Karearea project aims to re-establish this species in NZ by creating designated conservation areas and implementing habitat restoration efforts.

 - Trapping and eradicating predators
 - Providing habitat on uncultivated land

- ◆The connection to nature can create a captivating story and tasting experience.



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

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
